For this reason, we hereby make this Privacy Notice available to you, the purpose of which is to define the scope and general conditions applicable to your personal data, inform you about the personal data protection practices carried out by FQC, describe the type of personal information we collect from you, the purposes for which such information is used, with whom it may be shared, as well as the security measures implemented by FQC to protect the security and confidentiality of the personal information we receive.

The foregoing is intended to ensure that you are able to make informed decisions regarding the use of your personal data and to maintain control over and disposition of such data.

Identity and Address of the Data Controller

FIRST QUALITY CHEMICALS, S.A. DE C.V., hereinafter **FQC**, with its registered address at **Paseo de las Naciones No. 30, 3rd Floor, Suite 23, Lomas Verdes III Section, Naucalpan de Juárez, State of Mexico, C.P. 53125**, hereby informs you that it is responsible for the processing of personal data of visitors to its website www.firstqualitychemicals.com, as well as of its customers and/or prospective customers. Such personal data is processed in a strictly private and confidential manner.

Accordingly, the collection, processing, transfer, and exercise of rights derived from such personal data are carried out through appropriate, legitimate, and lawful use, permanently safeguarding the principles of legality, consent, quality, information, responsibility, loyalty, and purpose limitation, as well as the duties of security and confidentiality, in accordance with the **Federal Law on the Protection of Personal Data Held by Private Parties** (hereinafter, the "Law"), its Regulations, and applicable secondary provisions.

What Information Do We Collect?

In order to achieve the purposes established in this Privacy Notice, we expressly and limitatively indicate below the personal data that we may collect from you through our website:

We hereby inform you that **FQC will not request sensitive personal data** through its website, in accordance with the Law and its Regulations, for the purposes described herein.

What Do We Use Your Information For?

With respect to the personal data mentioned above, processing is guaranteed in accordance with the **primary purposes** that gave rise to and are necessary for the maintenance and fulfillment of the relationship established with our visitors, where applicable, as described below:

- (i) To contact you.
- (ii) To provide information regarding the products and services we offer.
- (iii) To follow up on and address your requests and/or complaints regarding the products and/or services provided by **FQC**.
- (iv) To refer your request to the appropriate department within **FQC** and address your inquiry.
- (v) To verify and confirm your identity when contracting any product with **FQC**.
- (vi) To request commercial references about you from third parties.
- (vii) To execute the corresponding contract with you and to fulfill the legal relationship established as a result of the acquisition of any of the products offered by **FQC**.
- (viii) To register you as an **FQC** customer and create a physical and/or electronic database.
- (ix) To provide you with information about new products offered by **FQC**.
- (x) To provide assistance and follow-up regarding any complaint, request, and/or order related to the products you contract with **FQC**.
- (xi) To prepare estimates and/or quotations regarding the products offered by **FQC**.
- (xii) In the event that you request a credit line for the acquisition of a product, to evaluate your request, determine payment terms, establish the authorized amount, and, where applicable, increase your credit line.
- (xiii) To carry out extrajudicial or judicial collection activities with respect to those customers who are part of our overdue accounts portfolio.
- (xiv) To provide training regarding the operation and handling of the products contracted with **FQC**.

It is important for you to have confidence that the personal data you provide will be treated with strict confidentiality, exclusively for the purposes described above, and only to the extent necessary to fulfill the purpose for which such data was collected.

Additionally, **FQC** may process your personal data for the following **secondary purposes**, which are not necessary to address your requests and/or needs as a visitor to our website, but which allow us to provide you with better service:

- Marketing
- Advertising
- Commercial prospecting
- Evaluation of **FQC** products and/or services

If you do not wish your personal data to be processed for the secondary purposes indicated above, you may notify us by sending an email to privacidad@firstqualitychemicals.com, in order to discontinue the processing of your information for such additional purposes. Otherwise, we will understand that you have granted your consent for the processing of your personal data for such purposes.

In order to prevent unauthorized access to your personal data and to ensure that the information is used for the purposes established in this Privacy Notice, we have implemented security measures involving physical, electronic, and administrative procedures, using appropriate controls that limit the use or disclosure of your data, allowing us to process such data properly and prohibiting the unauthorized extraction of any information containing personal data from systems that house **FQC** databases.

In the unlikely event that **FQC** intends to use your information for purposes different from or additional to those set forth in this Privacy Notice, prior to such processing we will notify you of our new Privacy Notice through a notice published on our website www.firstqualitychemicals.com, so that, should you choose not to authorize the processing of your information for the new purposes, you may inform us by sending an email to privacidad@firstqualitychemicals.com.

With Whom Do We Share Your Information? (Transfer of Personal Data)

We hereby inform you that we do not share your personal data with third parties, except when necessary in the cases provided for in this document and in accordance with the provisions of the Law and its Regulations.

Additionally, pursuant to Article 37 of the Law, we may transfer your personal data to third parties **without your consent** in the cases provided for therein, including the following:

- When the transfer is provided for in a law or international treaty to which Mexico is a party.
- When the transfer is necessary for medical prevention or diagnosis, the provision of healthcare assistance, medical treatment, or the management of health services in favor of our suppliers and/or providers of goods and/or services.
- When the transfer is made to controlling companies, subsidiaries, or affiliates under the common control of the data controller, or to a parent company or any company within the same corporate group as **FQC**, operating under the same internal processes and policies.
- When the transfer is necessary by virtue of a contract entered into or to be entered into, in the interest of the data subject, by **FQC** and a third party.
- When the transfer is necessary or legally required for the protection of a public interest or for the procurement or administration of justice.
- When the transfer is necessary for the recognition, exercise, or defense of a right in a judicial proceeding.
- When the transfer is necessary for the maintenance or fulfillment of a legal relationship between **FQC** and the data subject.

How Can You Exercise Your ARCO Rights and/or Revoke the Consent Granted to FQC?

ARCO Rights

You have the right to **access, rectify, cancel, or object** to the processing of your personal data (ARCO rights). In this regard, as the data subject, you have the right to know what personal data **FQC** holds about you, the purposes for which such data is used, and the conditions under which it is processed (**Access**), as well as to request that such data be corrected if it is inaccurate, outdated, or incomplete (**Rectification**), to instruct us to cancel such data when it is excessive or unnecessary for the purposes that justified its collection or when it is not being processed in accordance with applicable principles (**Cancellation**), or to object to the processing of your personal data for specific purposes (**Opposition**), in the cases permitted by the Federal Law on the Protection of Personal Data Held by Private Parties.

Revocation of Consent

At any time, you may revoke the consent you have granted for the processing of your personal data, so that we cease using such data. However, it is important for you to be aware that not in all cases will we be able to process your request or discontinue the use of your data immediately, as we may be required to continue processing your personal data due to a legal obligation. Likewise, you should consider that, for certain purposes, revoking your consent will result in the termination of your relationship with **FQC**.

In order to exercise your **ARCO rights** and/or revoke your consent, you must submit the institutional form implemented for requesting the revocation of consent and/or the exercise of **ARCO** rights at the offices located at **Paseo de las Naciones No. 30, 3rd Floor, Suite 23, Lomas Verdes III Section, Naucalpan de Juárez, State of Mexico, C.P. 53125**, and/or electronically by sending an email to **privacidad@firstqualitychemicals.com**. You must attach to such a request the documents that prove your identity (official identification) or, where applicable, the identity and authority of your legal representative, as well as the specific requirements indicated in each form.

FQC will address your request within the timeframes established by the Law and will inform you of the consequences that may arise as a result of the exercise of your rights.

If you believe that you have not received a response from **FQC**, or that the response provided is not satisfactory, you have the right to contact the **National Institute for Transparency, Access to Information and Protection of Personal Data (INAI)** to file a data protection request within fifteen (15) days following the date on which the deadline for **FQC** to respond to your request expires, in accordance with the Law and its Regulations, as well as with the procedure established for such purpose, or following the response issued by **FQC**, as applicable.

We hereby inform you that the exercise of **ARCO Rights** and the **revocation of your consent** shall be **free of charge**. You will only be required to cover any justified shipping costs or the cost of reproduction in copies or other formats.

How Can You Limit the Use and Disclosure of Your Personal Data?

We hereby inform you that, in order for you to limit the use or disclosure of your personal data, we make available to you the email address **privacidad@firstqualitychemicals.com**, so that our **Personal Data Department** may include you in the exclusion list known as “**data subjects without secondary purposes**”, thereby ensuring that your personal data is not processed for the secondary purposes mentioned in this document.

Use of Cookies, Web Beacons, or Other Technologies

We hereby inform you that, in order to collect the personal data detailed in this document, **FQC** does not use mechanisms in remote or local electronic, optical, or other communication media, nor any technology that allows the automatic and simultaneous collection of personal data at the time you interact with such media.

Amendments and Changes to the Privacy Notice

In the event of any update or modification to this Privacy Notice, **FQC** will notify you through a notice published on our website www.firstqualitychemicals.com within five (5) business days following such modification.

EXERCISE OF ARCO RIGHTS AND REVOCATION OF CONSENT

What Are ARCO Rights?

First Quality Chemicals

ARCO rights consist of the rights held by all personal data subjects vis-à-vis the controller of their personal data, to **Access, Rectify, Cancel, and Object** to the processing of their personal data at any time, except for the cases provided for under the Law. For a better understanding, each of these rights is described below.

Access

As the data subject of your personal data, you have the right to know what personal data **FQC** holds about you, the purposes for which such data is used, as well as information regarding the conditions and general aspects of its processing.

Accordingly, **FQC** guarantees the **right of Access** in three specific aspects:

- That the data subject may be aware of the actual existence of the processing to which their personal data is subject.
- That the data subject may have access to the personal data held by **FQC**.
- That the data subject may be informed of the essential circumstances of the processing, namely, the duty to inform the data subject of the type of personal data processed; each and every one of the purposes that justify the processing; the parties involved in the processing (data processors); and, in the event of transfers, the recipients thereof, the purposes of such transfers, the personal data transferred, among other information the data subject may wish to know.

The obligation of access shall be deemed fulfilled when **FQC** makes the personal data available to the data subject or provides such data through the issuance of simple copies, magnetic, optical, audio, visual, or holographic media, or by using other information technologies provided for in the corresponding Privacy Notice.

Rectification

As the data subject of your personal data, you have the right to request the rectification of such data if it is inaccurate, outdated, or incomplete. For this purpose, it is important that, in requests for the rectification of personal data, the data subject specifies the corrections to be made and provides the documentation supporting such request.

Likewise, if the personal information to be rectified has previously been transferred to national or foreign third parties, such third parties must be informed of this situation so that they may proceed with making the corresponding correction.

Cancellation

As the data subject of your personal data, you have the right to request the **cessation of processing by FQC**, that is, to request that your personal data be removed from all of our records or databases through the blocking of such data and its subsequent deletion. Likewise, you may request the cancellation of your personal data at any time when you

consider that such data is not being processed in accordance with the principles and duties described in the Policy and/or the Law.

It is important to note that the **right to cancellation is not absolute**, and **FQC** may deny the exercise of this right when:

When the data refers to the parties to a private, corporate, or administrative agreement, and such data is necessary for its development and performance.

- When the data must be processed pursuant to a legal provision.
- When the deletion of the data would hinder judicial or administrative proceedings related to tax obligations, the investigation and prosecution of crimes, or the updating of administrative sanctions.
- When the data is necessary to protect the legally protected interests of the data subject; to carry out an action in the public interest; or to comply with a legally acquired obligation of the data subject.
- When the data is subject to processing for medical prevention or diagnosis, or for the management of health services, provided that such processing is carried out by a healthcare professional subject to a duty of confidentiality.

Opposition

As the data subject of your personal data, you have the right at any time to **object to the processing** of your personal data for specific purposes or to require that such processing be ceased when:

I. There is a legitimate cause and your specific situation so requires, which must justify that, even when the processing is lawful, it should be discontinued in order to prevent its continuation from causing harm to the data subject; or

II. It is necessary for you to express your objection to the processing of your personal data so that such data is not processed for specific purposes.

It is important to inform you that the exercise of the right of opposition shall **not apply** in cases where the processing of personal data is necessary to comply with a legal obligation incumbent upon **FQC**.

ARCO rights may be exercised **without any predetermined order**, and the exercise of any one of them is not a prerequisite for the exercise of any other.

What Is the Revocation of Consent?

In addition to the exercise of **ARCO Rights**, personal data subjects may revoke their consent to the processing of their personal data at any time, provided that such revocation is not prevented by a legal provision.

It is important to consider that there are **two modalities** under which consent may be revoked:

1. **With respect to all consented purposes**, meaning that the data controller ceases all processing of the data subject's personal data; or
2. **With respect to specific processing activities**, such as, by way of example, processing for marketing, advertising, or commercial research purposes, among others.

Under the second modality, namely **partial revocation of consent**, other processing purposes that the controller may carry out in accordance with its Privacy Notice and with which the data subject agrees shall remain unaffected.

PROCEDURE FOR THE EXERCISE OF ARCO RIGHTS

In order to exercise your **ARCO Rights**, you must submit an **ARCO Rights Request** through any of the following means:

- (i) in person at the offices located at **Paseo de las Naciones No. 30, 3rd Floor, Suite 23, Lomas Verdes III Section, Naucalpan de Juárez, State of Mexico, C.P. 53125**; and/or
- (ii) by sending an email to **privacidad@firstqualitychemicals.com**.

The institutional form for exercising **ARCO Rights** is available on our website www.firstqualitychemicals.com, and you may also request it from our **Personal Data Department** by emailing **privacidad@firstqualitychemicals.com**.

You must attach to such request the documents required to verify your identity by providing a photocopy of any official identification. If acting on behalf of a third party, you must submit a copy of the notarized power of attorney, a power of attorney signed before two witnesses, or a declaration made during the personal appearance of the data subject, as applicable, along with official identification.

The **ARCO Rights Request** must be addressed to the **Personal Data Department**, which will verify that the request contains all the required information, including the following:

- The full name of the data subject, telephone number, address, an email address, or another means by which the response to the request may be delivered.
- A valid document proving the identity of the data subject.
- A description of the personal data with respect to which the data subject wishes to exercise their rights, as well as the reasons motivating such request.
- Any other element or document that facilitates the location of the personal data.
- In the case of a request for the rectification of personal data, the data subject must additionally indicate the modifications to be made and provide the documentation supporting such request.

PROCEDURE FOR THE REVOCATION OF CONSENT

The **data subject**, with respect to their data, may revoke their consent for the processing of their personal data in accordance with the Law, by submitting the request that **FQC** makes available to the data subject for such purposes, after prior request to the responsible party through the means described above. The data subject must verify their identity by providing a photocopy of any official identification. If acting on behalf of a third party, a copy of the notarized power of attorney, a power of attorney signed before two witnesses, or a declaration made during the personal appearance of the data subject, as applicable, must be submitted, along with official identification.

The **Request** must be addressed to the **Personal Data Department**, which will verify that the request contains the required information in the "Request for Revocation of Consent," including the following:

- The **full name** of the data subject, their **telephone number, address, email address**, and other means by which the response to their request can be notified.
- **Valid document** verifying the identity of the data subject.
- The indication of whether the revocation of consent applies to **all consented purposes**, meaning that **FQC** will cease all processing of the data subject's personal data, or, in the case of specific processing activities, the data subject must specify the purposes for which they wish to revoke consent and request that their data is no longer processed for those specific purposes.
- Any other **element or document** that facilitates the location of the personal data.

In the event that the request for the exercise of **ARCO Rights** and/or **Revocation of Consent** does not include the indication of an address or other means to notify the response, **FQC** may consider it as not submitted and will leave a record of that.

If the request is unclear, insufficient, erroneous, or incomplete, **FQC** may ask the data subject to provide additional information within **5 business days** of receiving the request, and if no response is provided, the request will be deemed as not submitted.

The data subject will have **10 business days** to attend to the additional information request from **FQC**, starting from the next day after receiving it, and if the data subject does not provide the requested information, the request will be considered not submitted.

FQC will have a maximum period of **15 business days**, starting from the date of receipt of the request, to inform the data subject whether the request is accepted or not. If the request is accepted, **FQC** will make the necessary modifications within **10 business days**. The deadlines mentioned in this paragraph may be extended once, for the same period, provided **FQC** justifies it.

FQC will respond in a timely manner to the requests presented, in full compliance with the Law. Likewise, **FQC** may deny the revocation of consent for the processing of personal data in the cases provided for by the Law and its Regulations.

When the data subject requests confirmation of the cessation of the processing of their personal data, **FQC** will explicitly respond to that request.

We hereby inform you that the exercise of **ARCO Rights** and the **Revocation of Consent** shall be **free of charge**. You will only be required to cover any justified shipping costs or the cost of reproduction in copies or other formats.

"PROCEDURE FOR EXERCISING ARCO RIGHTS"

DESCRIPTION OF ARCO RIGHTS AND RELEVANT INFORMATION

RIGHT OF ACCESS

This right allows you to be informed about the personal data being processed. If possible, it is recommended to provide any information or documentation that facilitates the location of your personal data.

RIGHT OF RECTIFICATION

This right allows you to have your personal data corrected when the data is incorrect, inaccurate, incomplete, or outdated.

You must specify which data you wish to have rectified, as well as provide the necessary supporting documentation.

RIGHT OF CANCELLATION

This right allows you to request that your data be deleted from the databases, so that they no longer remain in use. The data will be blocked and later deleted from the databases.

This request applies when personal data is no longer necessary for the activities for which it was collected, and no longer required when such data must be retained for the time periods established by applicable legal provisions or existing contractual relationships.

RIGHT OF OPPOSITION

This right allows you to request that the company cease processing your personal data for specific situations.

It is necessary to specify the legitimate reasons for your opposition to the processing.

COST

The exercise of ARCO Rights is free of charge, and only the justified cost of shipping or reproduction in copies or other formats will be covered. If any of the rights are exercised within less than twelve months, the cost cannot exceed the equivalent of three days of the general minimum wage in Mexico City.

CLARIFICATION REQUEST

If the data provided is incorrect, incomplete, or unclear, we will require you to complete or clarify it within 5 business days. You will have 10 business days to address the additional information request, after which, if no response is provided, the request will be considered not submitted.

RESPONSE TIME FOR YOUR REQUEST

The deadline for us to communicate a response to you is 20 business days, which may be extended once for justified reasons. The justification for the extension will be notified within the same period, starting from the day the request is received.

If your request is accepted, your ARCO rights will be effective within 15 business days following the date of the response. This deadline may also be extended once for justified reasons, and the justification for the extension will be notified within the same period.

PROCEDURE FOR THE REVOCATION OF CONSENT

Instructions: Any data subject interested in revoking their consent for the processing of their personal data must follow the steps below:
